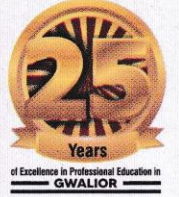



Minutes of the Meetings of Institute Academic Council

held on 8th Feb, 2022 at 03:30 pm

Venue: Prestige Institute of Management & Research, Gwalior

- Last Meeting minutes held on 25th September, 2021 were confirmed.
- The Academic Council ratified and approved the minutes of all Board of Studies. Council suggested updating the course curriculum of all the programs as per industry needs. The UG programs to be updated according to NEP 2020. The value added courses proposed by the board were appreciated and approved for inclusion in the internal components.
- External and internal panel members for setting question papers were approved. Council suggested adding external moderators for the screening of question papers set by the faculty members. Council emphasized on the inclusion of external experts in the committee.
- Admission plan for the session 2022-23 was shared amongst the council members. Members suggested promoting the programmes among students of different regions across the nation. The council advised to plan course specific webinars with key alumni to promote the courses.
- Dr Navita Nathani reported the successful conduction of the ATAL FDP on “Design Thinking” held during 7th to 11th December 2021.
- Successful accomplishment of Webinar sponsored by National Commission for Women on “Deface the Acid Attackers: Resilience against Violence” on 30th Dec, 2021 by Mr. Aakash Gupta was reported.
- The conduction of 13th International Conference in collaboration with AIBPM held in hybrid mode was reported. The members appreciated the institute for the efforts to continue the academic rigor.
- The preparation of Advance Excel Workshop to be held during April 8th – 13th, 2022 was reported. The Doctoral Colloquium conducted on 18th Dec, 2021 guiding research skills and Entrepreneurial awareness program (to be held on Feb 24, 2022) highlights were also shared with the Council.

- A report on faculty publications with around 32 Scopus and 6 Web of Sciences publications was presented. The disbursement of research incentives to the faculty members for these quality publications was appreciated by the Council. Provision for providing more financial assistance for research promotion was also acknowledged and forwarded for approval.

- The council approved the Research policy 2022 for promoting the research interest among faculty members, which includes incentives for publications in Emerald/Sage/Springer/Routledge/SciPress/InderScience/Wiley/Blackwell/Elsevier/IEEE /Science Direct/ and Taylor & Francis. The policy also highlights maintaining ethics in the research report writing.

- Several MoUs with institutions and organizations were done to organize collaborative activities in future:

Genuine Education, Indore (21-22) for Trainings of MBA students; Shriram Life Insurance (2021-2022) for Internship of 30 students; Srajan Welfare Society (2021-22) for Internship of 42 students; Gurukul Education (2021-2022) for Summer Trainings of 45 students; Renaissance Educare (2021-22) for Internship of 48 students; Digital Height (Sep 2021 to Sep 2023) for Internship of 20 students; Workshopedia (2021-23) for Expert sessions and Internship of 20 students; Motilal Oswal (2021-23) for Internship of 35 students; Precision Industrial System(2021-23) for Industrial Tour of 100 students;

Association of International Business And Professional Management , Indonesia (AIBPM) for Research, Faculty and Student Exchange; University Sains Malaysia, Penang Malaysia (2022-25) for Research, Faculty and Student Exchange; Universitas Mahasaraswati Denpasar, Indonesia (2022-25) for Research, Faculty and Student Exchange; Debre Tabor University, Ethopia (2019-23) for Research, Faculty exchange and Student Exchange; ASEZ Korea for Research, Faculty and Student Exchange; AMDISA for Research; & The University of Molise, Italy (2021-24) for research and student exchange.

- The Information regarding the purchase of laptops for faculty members and Installation of Interactive boards in UG and PG classrooms was shared. The committee members appreciated the management for the same.
- HoI updated on the status of AQAR preparations. Council suggested doing the preparatory work of AQAR and intensify the activities criterion wise.
- The Audit and feedback received by the stakeholders were discussed with the Council to understand the gaps. The presented Action taken reports were evaluated for further strengthening the systems and syllabi for meeting the requirements. The council recommended ways to enrich academic activities in the institute. The strategic plan and its implementation against timeline was also assessed and reviewed.
- The Council also advised HoI to arrange for Green-Energy Audit of the institute and share the report. The ISO certification awarded on 26th April, 2021 was also reported.
