At Prestige Institute of Management & Research Gwalior, the Management, Faculty and Students strive all-together to achieve the objective of comprehensive skill development.




Figure 1: Areas focused by the Institute for Skill Development

• Entrepreneurship Development cell:

Entrepreneurs fuel the economic growth of the country by boosting the GDP as well as creating employment opportunities. Entrepreneurs often introduce innovative products, services, and business models that disrupt existing markets and solve problems in new ways. At Prestige Institute of Management and Research, Gwalior, the Entrepreneurship Development cell strives to motivate students to start their own ventures. Entrepreneurship Development Programs and Hackathons are conducted regularly.

During the year 2018-19, To contribute to the country's mission of Entrepreneurial development, A four-week entrepreneurship Development Program in association with MPCON Gwalior was organised from 24/10/18 to 26/11/18. During the program sessions were conducted on various themes such as Entrepreneurship and its Characteristics. Personality development topics like achievement motivation training, tools for effective communication and public speaking were discussed with the participants. Sessions on the Role of DTIC, State & Central Govt. Schemes operated by DTIC, and other supporting agencies were also conducted. Some basic topics like definition Business/ Service/ Industry/ Intellectual Property Rights and its basis of selection, screening of ideas and business opportunities identification were also explained.

Panel discussion on the society readiness, problems, and challenges for women entrepreneurs in Indian Society was also organised. In the end of the program Industry Visit was organised to Priya gold Biscuits Factory situated in Malanpur area. Apart from this, students also learned to make project plans which were evaluated after completion.

TEDP (Technical Entrepreneurship Program) was organised from 14/11/19 to 06/01/20 In Association with MPCON Gwalior on "low-cost building material" for the students of science and technology background. For becoming participants, they had to undergo with the rigorous interview process. The program was designed so that the students can learn the use of technology in identifying business opportunities in manufacturing and service sectors. The lectures on conducting a market survey, essential technical skills for digital marketers and opportunities in service marketing for technology-based entrepreneurship were conducted. Besides this the lectures on personality development and goal setting were conducted to improvise behavioral skills of budding entrepreneurs The biggest challenge in front of entrepreneur is to manage time and to keep in mind the same some of the lectures were conducted on time management and stress management as well. Apart from this the sessions were conducted on preparation of project feasibility report, Intellectual property rights and legal formalities for establishing SSI. A visit to Taragram, Orchha was also planned in the end of the program where students visited small and cottage units of handicrafts, fly ash bricks and stationary products.



Role Plays, Business Quiz, Project Assignments, and case studies are used to enhance learning. The use of ERP and FTP by students and faculty is intensified at PIMR, Gwalior. This initiative was helpful in creating a synergistic effect, providing students with a more engaging and relevant educational experience. Smart boards in the classrooms also play an important role.

Also, New teaching pedagogies become part of internal assessment, introduced every year for 360-degree development of students like LTM (Learning through movies), up-skilling through Value Added Courses, Story Telling Component-Book Review, (Inculcating habit of reading and linking to subject taught) HQD (Human quality Development), Business Forum, Major Research Project, Know the Unknown Vlogs and Virtual Share Trading. These innovative teaching pedagogies are a part of the internal component for our courses.





Evidence of Success:

The behavioral skills and Confidence of students has developed greatly which is visible through the placement records of the institute. Students have developed public speaking as well as interpersonal skills. They are highly oriented for their career growth. They have also developed practical and critical thinking resulting in enhanced employability.

- We are glad to share that in 2019, total number of organizations visited is 94 (online and offline mode) and total number of offer letter rolled out is 801 and out of 603, 492 has been placed in various esteemed organizations. Highest package was 12 LPA and Avg was 4.52 LPA for PG, highest package was 10 LPA, Avg was 3.35 LPA for UG.
- ➤ In 2020, 37 of our students got placed with annual CTC of 10.00 LPA or above, among the batch size of 278 students of MBA full time 259 students got placed with 96 organizations with maximum package of 12.00 LPA and average package of 4.52 LPA.
- Summarizing the placement opportunities provided to the students of 2021 batch we are glad to share 17 of our students got placed with annual CTC of 10.00 LPA or above, among the batch size of 287 students of MBA full time 269 students got placed with 107 organizations with maximum package of 12.00 LPA and average package of 4.66 LPA.
- In the session ending June 2023, The highest package in the batch accounted to 13.68 lakhs. 144 companies visited the campus for recruitment drives and 614 offers were received.




Sectoral Representation of Companies-2022-23

- Optimism, emotional intelligence and improved social interactions were also reflected in most of the students, Self-awareness and a healthier outlook on life is the need of the hour.
- Students approach Mentors for discussion related to career and mental health without hesitation and trust has developed between the two.
- Industrial visits promote the development of soft skills, such as communication, listening, and observation skills.
- Visiting successful industries and witnessing their achievements can be highly motivating and inspiring for participants. It can instill a sense of ambition and drive them to excel in their chosen fields.
- It also bridges the gap in theory and practice. Students in various courses have learned Digital marketing and Tally to their technical up-gradation in addition to academics which is a major addition to the set of their career related skills.

Problems Encountered/ Resources Required:

- Introduction of new pedagogy for courses every year was difficult but gradually teachers took more interest and as per their subject syllabus they created many unique pedagogies.
- Many students studying in the institute belong to semi urban/rural areas. They face major difficulties such as communication, vocabulary, stage fear and language barriers. Tailoring skill development programs to meet the specific requirements of these students was a challenge. This issue was resolved by seeking help from various trainers and industry experts.
- Balancing skill development alongside academics can be challenging for the students so emphasis was also given on Time and Stress management workshops.
- There is a need for additional infrastructure to manage skill development activities such as additional GD room and seminar halls. The institute has requested the management for the same.
- The effectiveness of any workshops varies depending on individual's commitment to self-improvement also.
- Skill development is a continuous process that requires consistent effort and practice.
