- The minutes of the previous meeting held on 26th July, 2022, were confirmed.
- The Academic Council ratified the minutes of all Board of Studies in the institute and approved the syllabi for the academic year 2022-23 for all the programs.
- The Admission plan for the session 2023-24 was shared among the council members. It was suggested to promote the programs among students from different regions across the nation. The council advised planning course-specific webinars to further promote the courses.
- The successful conduction of the ATAL Faculty Development Program (FDP) titled "Using HR Analytics for Managing Workplace Behaviors" from 19/09/2022 to 30/09/2022 was reported to the board.
- The proposal for the grand Silver Jubilee Celebration on 5th & 6th May, 2023, of the institute was shared among the committee members, along with details about several working committees under the same.
- The proposal and preparations for the AICTE sponsored 14th International Conference, 2023, scheduled on 11th-12th Feb, 2023, were reported to the council.
- Faculty members exhibited an impressive dedication to scholarly pursuits, resulting in the publication of approximately 75 research papers and chapters in books. Notably, our faculty members contributed to esteemed journals, with 32 publications indexed in Scopus, 15 in ABDC, and an additional 4 in Web of Science journals. The proposed workshops on Reference Manager, eviews, and Jamovi for students, along with an Editor's Conclave to understand editors' expectations, were discussed with the members. The council congratulated the institution for offering research incentives of Two Lacs Forty Nine thousand

- and Ninety Nine, to faculty members for their notable publications in high indexed journals.
- The council appreciated Prestige Research Centre for awarding its first PhD on 24th February 2022.
- The Library Committee was advised to take necessary initiatives for library upgradation and submit the report.
- The council congratulated the institute for initiating the infrastructural development for supporting better student learning environment. Permission for further construction on existing blocks was obtained; HoI informed that the construction will commence in October, including air conditioning.
