# NCMEI ACT

Citation: (2002) 8 SCALE 1: AIR2003SC355

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T.M.A. Pai Foundation and others v. State of Karnataka and others [11 Judge Bench]

From the majority judgment, the following Salient points were be culled out:

- 1. The term 'minority' in Art. 30(1) covers linguistic and religious minorities.
- 2. For the purpose of determining the 'minority', the unit will be the State and not the whole of India. Thus, religious and linguistic minorities, which have been placed at par in Art. 30, have to be considered State-wise.
- 3. Art. 30(1) gives religious and linguistic minorities the right to establish and administer educational institutions 'of their choice'. The use of the words 'of their choice' indicates that even professional educational institutions would be covered by art. 30.
- 4. The right conferred on the minorities by Art. 30(1) is not absolute. It has to be read subject to Art. 29(2) and other fundamental rights. Minority educational institutions thus become divisible into two categories, viz.: aided educational institutions and unaided educational institutions. The unaided institutions enjoy much greater autonomy than aided institutions.
- 5. Admission of students to unaided minority educational institutions cannot be regulated by the State or the concerned university, except for providing the qualifications and minimum conditions of eligibility in the interest of academic standards.

The right to admit students is an essential facet of the right to administer educational institutions of their choice the State Government or the University may not be entitled to interfere with that tight so long as the admission to the unaided educational institutions is on a transparent basis and merit is adequately taken care of.

In case of unaided professional institutions, provision can be made for merit-based selection while giving the management sufficient discretion to admit students.

6. Because of the interplay of Art. 29 (2) with Art. 30(1), an aided minority institution is entitled to admit students belonging to the minority group. At the same time, it is also required to admit non-minority students to a reasonable extent, whereby the character of the institution is not annihilated, and, at the same time, the rights of the citizen engrafted under Art. 29(2) are not subverted.

What would be a 'reasonable' extent, would vary from the type of institution, the courses of education for which admission is being sought and other factors like educational needs.

It is for the concerned State Government to notify the percentage of non-minority students to be admitted in the light of the above indicia.

7. Observance of inter se merit amongst the minority students could also be ensured.

In case of aided professional institutions, it can also be stipulated that passing of the common entrance test held by the State agency is necessary to seek admission.

In case of non-minority students eligible to seek admission should normally be on the basis of the common entrance test held for the remaining seats, admission by the State agency followed by counseling wherever it exists.

8. A minority institution may have its own procedure and method of admission as well as selection of students, so long as the procedure is fair and transparent.

The selection of students in professional and education colleges should be on the basis of merit. The procedure adopted or selection made should not be tantamount to mal-administration.

Even an unaided minority institution ought not to ignore the merit of the students for admission; otherwise it will fail to achieve excellence.

9. While giving aid to professional institutions, the aid giving authority may prescribe the conditions on the basis of which admissions will be granted by the aided colleges by virtue of merit, coupled with the reservation policy of the State qua non-minority students.

The merit may be determined on the basis of an entrance examination conducted by the University or the State concerned. The authority concerned may devise other means also to ensure that admissions are granted on the basis of merit in educational institutions.

10. The right to administer, not being absolute, there could be regulatory measures for ensuring educational standards and maintaining excellence thereof.

Conditions of affiliation or recognition of unaided institutions can comprise conditions pertaining to the academic and educational character of the institution and ensure uniformity, efficiency and excellence in educational courses. But these conditions should not be such as to lead to governmental control.

In case of unaided educational institutions, the regulatory measures of control regulating facets of administration should be minimal. An unaided institution must have greater autonomy than an aided institution. It must have autonomy in such matters as appointment of staff, taking disciplinary action against staff, admission of students, charging of fees etc.

A rational method of selecting teachers and for taking disciplinary action against them has to be evolved by the management. There is no need for the management of a private unaided institution to seek prior permission or approval of a government authority to take disciplinary action against a staff member. For redressing grievances of employees of aided as well as unaided institutions who are subjected to punishment or termination of service, a mechanism need to be evolved. Appropriate tribunals presided over by judicial officers of the rank of district judges could be established.

The State or other controlling agencies could prescribe minimum qualifications and experience for the teaching staff.

11. The aid giving authority can, as a condition of granting aid, put restraints on the freedom of administration and management of the institution. Conditions may be imposed as are necessary for the proper maintenance of the high standard of education as the financial burden is shared by the State. Interests of the staff have also to be protected.

An aided institution cannot have the same autonomy in the matter of administration and management as a private unaided institution, but, at the same time, it cannot be treated as a government institution. Regulations may be framed governing service conditions for teaching and other staff for whom aid is provided but without interfering with the over-all administrative control of the management over the staff.

- 12. Fees chargeable by unaided institutions cannot be regulated but no capitation fee can be charged. In aided institutions, fees can be so charged that there is no profiteering. Reasonable surplus to meet cost of expansion and augmentation of facilities does not, however, amount to profiteering.
- 13. All citizens have a right to establish and administer educational institutions under Arts. 19(1)(g) and 26(a).

The word 'occupation' in Art. 19(1)(g) covers such an activity. Such institutions are however subject of Arts. 19(b) and 26(1), but this is subject to the right of the minority institutions to admit minority students.

Such religious denominations or sections thereof as do not fall within the special categories carved out in Art. 29(1) and 30(1) can establish and maintain religious and educational institutions under Art. 26(a). The religious and linguistic minorities have an additional right to establish educational institutions under Art. 30(1), in addition to Arts. 19(1) (g) and 26(a).

Thus, the Constitution recognizes the right of an individual or a linguistic minority or a religious denomination or a religious minority to establish educational institutions.

- (I) "Professional Educational Institution" means a college or a school or an institute by whatever name called, imparting professional education, affiliated to state university including a private university established or incorporated by an Act of the State Legislature or Constituent unit of a deemed to be university under section 3 of University Grant Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956), and approved or recognized by the competent statutory body regulating professional education;
- (m) "Qualifying Examination" means the examination of the minimum qualification, passing of which entitles one to seek admission into the relevant Professional Courses as prescribed in these rules;
- (n) "CMAT" means Common Management Admission Test;
- (o) "TFW Seats" means Tuition fee waiver seats, seats which are available maximum up to 5% of approved admission capacity in all institutions approved by AICTE. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature. These seats will be available for Madhya Pradesh domicile candidate whose family annual income from all sources should not be more than ₹ 8.00 Lac (Rupees Eight Lac Only).
- (p) "Reservation for Economical weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh" means As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh GAD Letter No. एफ-07-11/2019/आ.प्र./एक भोपाल, Dated 02 july 2019, Ten Percent (10 %) Seats of approved intake will be available for admission in Masters of Business Administration (MBA) and Allied courses for Economically weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh.

The words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

#### Other Abbreviations Used In This Rule Book Are:-

- (i) "CTE" means commissioner Technical Education, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal;
- (ii) "RGPV" means Rajiv Gandhi Prodyogiki Vishvavidhyalaya, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal;
- (iii) "General Pool" means after provision of 5% seats to NRI candidates remaining 95% seats shall be called General Pool Seats [in which reservation for SC, ST & OBC (Excluding Creamy layer) will be available for M.P. Domicile candidates as per govt. notification]

#### 2.3. <u>Applicability:</u>

These rules shall be applicable to private unaided professional institutions which are conducting **MBA (FT)** courses as approved by the AICTE.

#### 2.4. Admission rules -

In all professional institutions the procedure for admission shall be as under-

#### 2.4.1 Availability of seats –

Number of seats available in various management institutions in Madhya Pradesh are as follows:

#### 2.4.3 J&K Migrant's Seats:

One seat, on over and above basis, in each of the Institution is reserved for J&K migrants. The admission shall be given on the basis of merit as decided by the CMAT 2022 test conducted by AICTE. The candidate shall have to produce a certificate as given in **Proforma-7 (Annexure-4)** duly signed by competent authority.

Sons/daughters of the employees of MP Government who have served in the State of Jammu & Kashmir for curbing insurgency are also covered under the J&K migrant. Such candidates should have passed their qualifying examination from the State of J&K. Candidates shall have to produce a certificate in **Proforma-8 (Annexure-5)** of this rule book at the time of Counselling.

#### 2.4.4 J&K Resident's Seats:-

One seat each in all institutions has been reserved for residents of Jammu & Kashmir. The candidates seeking admission against these reserved seats shall be required to appear in CMAT 2022 test conducted by AICTE and submit appropriate certificate issued by the competent Authority. These seats shall be considered under General Pool.

#### 2.4.5 NRI Seats:

Institutions those get permission from AICTE, New Delhi for 5% NRI Seats of total intake capacity. Admission against these seats will be carried out as per the regulation published in MP Government Gazette dated 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2011 for admission against NRI seats "Admission (Reservation to non-resident Indian in AICTE Approved Courses) Regulations, 2011."

#### 2.4.6 Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme Seats (TFW)

Under this scheme, upto a maximum of 5% of "Approved Intake" in MBA Course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumery in nature. These supernumery seats shall be available in MBA Institution, where a minimum of 50% of "Approved Intake" are filled up in previous session.

These seats will be available for Madhya Pradesh domicile candidate whose family annual income from all sources should not be more than ` 8.00 Lac (Rupees Eight Lac Only).

The Tuition Fee Waiver scheme is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Govt. for the Govt./ Govt. Aided/ Autonomous Institutions and in case of private institutions tuition fee approved by the Admission & Fee Regulatory Committee, Madhya Pradesh. All other fees shall have to be paid by the Candidate.

In case of unavailability of the candidates for these seats; these seats will not be convert for others.

Admission for these seats will be done by centralize Counseling only and admission procedure for these seats will be same as notified by the competent authority for regular admission. The candidates of Madhya Pradesh will be eligible for admission on these seats.

# 2.4.7 Reservation for Economical weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh:-

As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh GAD Letter No. एफ-07-11/2019/आ.प्र./एक भोपाल, Dated 02 july 2019, Ten Percent (10 %) Seats of approved intake will be available for admission in MBA institutes for Economically weaker section (EWS) candidates of Madhya Pradesh. These seats will be available for Madhya Pradesh domicile candidate whose family annual income from all sources should not be more than ₹ 8.00 Lac (Rupees Eight Lac Only).

A candidate claiming for Economical weaker section (EWS) Seat shall have to produce a certificate from the competent authority in **Proforma**-**11 (Annexure-8)** as given in this rule book, As per the Government of Madhya Pradesh GAD Letter No. एफ-07-11/ 2019/आ.प्र./एक भोपाल, Dated 02 july 2019 and latest order issued by the Govt. of M.P. regarding Economical weaker section (EWS).

#### 2.5 Eligibility for admission –

#### 2.5.1 The Candidates should be an Indian National.

#### 2.5.2 Educational Qualifications:

#### 2.5.2.1 MBA (Full Time) & ALLIED COURSES:

A candidate seeking admission to MBA and Allied Courses should be a Graduate with at least 50% marks and 45% marks in case of SC, ST, OBC (excluding Creamy Layer) category of Madhya Pradesh in aggregate of any UGC/AICTE approved Indian University or from a foreign University recognized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) or institute recognized by the concerned University as equivalent thereto. The Bachelor's degree must be of minimum three years duration after passing Higher Secondary (10+2) examination of (10+2) system or equivalent.

**NOTE** :- Candidates in the Final year of above degree examination can also appear in the CMAT 2022 test on provisional basis. Such a candidate shall have to produce the original certificate "having passed/mark sheet" showing aggregate marks of the degree program at the time of counselling; however, candidate shall have to fill all the entries of qualifying examination at the time of counselling registration.

#### 2.5.3 Domicile Requirements:

No candidate belonging to SC, ST & OBC (Excluding Creamy Layer) category shall be selected for admission against the seats reserved for them unless;

**12.9** Admission in minority status colleges:

Minority institutions will have to register on the portal of the Higher Education Department (<u>http://www.mphighereducation.nic.in</u>) and enter information and enter information about the courses/subject run by the respective university in their institution, their seat number, fees etc. on the portal and verification of these courses will have to be done from the concerned mapping college by the prescribed date.

There will be no restriction of reservation for SC/ST/OBC in minority institutions. Minority institutions will have to enter the information about the students admitted in them in the online module available on the e-admission portal of the department (www.epravesh.nic.in). This process will have to be completed by the last date fixe for reporting as per the online admission process table.
