About the activity

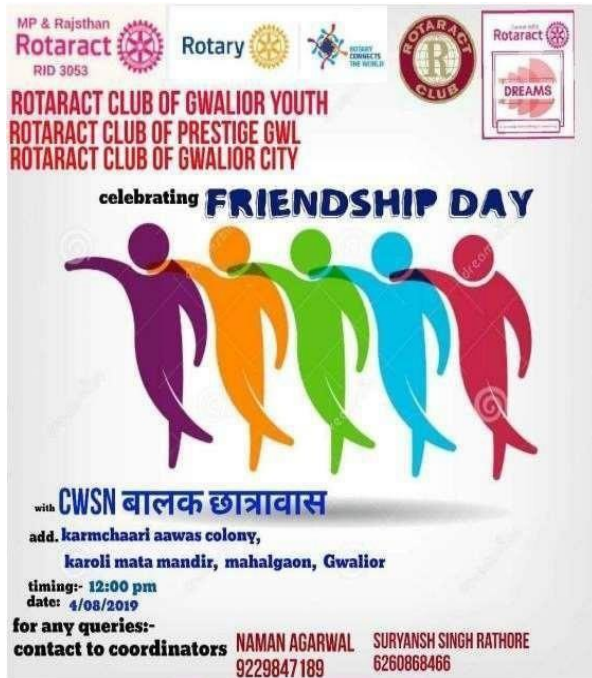
